

ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS POLICY

It is the stated policy of WRR (UK) Limited to ensure that as far as is reasonably practical, no damage will be done to any part of the environment as a result of works being carried out by the Company.

Materials

Materials used in the course of works on site, insofar as they are fit for purpose, will be selected on the basis of environmental compatibility and those less likely to cause harm will take preference.

Method Statements are prepared for all WRR (UK) individual jobs. These govern the correct storage, usage and disposal of all materials to be used. All potentially hazardous materials reviewed and COSHH information together with a Risk Analysis relating to their use is made available to all parties. This information is posted up at sites adjacent to work areas.

Noise & Pollution

Some of the techniques that have to be used by WRR (UK) are inherently noisy and can produce significant quantities of dust. WRR (UK) minimise the impact on local residents by the use of silenced tools and plant whenever this is practical and the proper screening and sealing off of their work. WRR (UK) always co-operate with Local Environmental Officers, Tenants' Associations and the like to warn them of the possible impact and duration of work.

Chemicals & Hazardous Materials

In common with most elements of the Building Industry, some materials WRR (UK) use tend to be hazardous in their raw state. For example, cementitious mortars now in use are highly alkaline, but are less damaging to the environment than some resin or solvent based compounds. This is recognised by the manufacturers and by WRR (UK), and COSHH statements, covering all aspects of the safe and responsible handling of materials, are published and observed on all sites.

Waste Disposal

This is an area often overlooked by Health & Safety policies. WRR (UK), however, ensure that proper waste disposal facilities are always provided and surplus materials are adapted into their least offensive form before binning.

The Company also takes steps to prevent access by the general public (particularly children) to its waste. WRR (UK) only use properly certified Waste Disposal Contractors to carry away debris.
